

PacketSnitch End User License Agreement (EULA)

Effective Date: July 31, 2026

This End User License Agreement ("Agreement") is a legally binding agreement between you ("User", "you", or "your") and **Marshall Whittaker, doing business as oxasploits** ("oxasploits", "we", "our", or "us") governing your installation and use of PacketSnitch, including any associated software, documentation, updates, plugins, themes, extensions, and related services (collectively, the "Software").

By downloading, installing, copying, accessing, or using PacketSnitch, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by the terms of this Agreement. If you do not agree with these terms, you must not install or use the Software.

1. License Grant

Subject to your compliance with this Agreement, oxasploits grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to install and use PacketSnitch for lawful purposes.

This Agreement grants you a license to use the Software and does not transfer ownership of the Software or any intellectual property rights.

2. Ownership

PacketSnitch and all associated trademarks, logos, artwork, branding, documentation, and proprietary components are owned by Marshall Whittaker, doing business as oxasploits.

Certain components of PacketSnitch may be released under one or more open source licenses. Those components remain governed by their respective licenses. Nothing in this Agreement limits or replaces the rights granted under those licenses.

Commercial themes, plugins, premium content, branding assets, and other proprietary materials remain the exclusive property of oxasploits unless expressly licensed otherwise.

3. Acceptable Use

You agree to use PacketSnitch only for lawful purposes and in compliance with all applicable local, state, federal, and international laws and regulations.

You agree that you will not:

- Circumvent licensing or security mechanisms.
- Redistribute proprietary components without authorization.
- Remove copyright or attribution notices.
- Attempt to interfere with PacketSnitch services or infrastructure.
- Use PacketSnitch in violation of applicable law or the rights of others.

You remain solely responsible for your use of PacketSnitch and any data analyzed by the Software.

4. Privacy and Optional Metrics

PacketSnitch is designed to perform packet analysis primarily on your own computer.

Packet captures, imported files, analysis results, API keys, authentication credentials, prompts, payloads, and other user data are not transmitted to oxasploits unless you expressly choose to submit diagnostic information or enable optional metrics collection.

PacketSnitch may request your consent to submit anonymous diagnostic or metrics information to help improve the Software.

Participation is entirely optional.

When enabled, metrics are intended to include technical information such as:

- Software version
- Operating system information
- Feature usage
- Error reports
- Crash diagnostics
- Performance metrics

PacketSnitch is designed to exclude, to the extent reasonably practicable:

- Packet capture files (PCAP/PCAPNG)
- Imported files
- Packet payloads
- User documents
- API keys
- Authentication credentials
- LLM prompts
- LLM responses
- Personally identifiable information

You may decline or disable optional metrics collection at any time.

oxasploits does not sell your personal information or diagnostic information to third parties.

5. Internet Connectivity

Certain PacketSnitch features may communicate with Internet services, including:

- Software updates
- Version checks
- License validation
- Plugin downloads
- Theme downloads
- Optional metrics submission
- Third-party integrations

Your use of these features necessarily involves communication over public networks.

oxasploits is not responsible for the privacy practices, logging, monitoring, or policies of Internet service providers, network operators, governments, or third-party services.

6. Third-Party Services

PacketSnitch may integrate with third-party services including, but not limited to:

- Paddle
- Ollama
- VirusTotal
- Other user-configured APIs

These services are operated independently.

Your use of those services is governed by their own terms of service and privacy policies.

Any API keys, subscriptions, usage charges, or licensing costs associated with third-party services are solely your responsibility.

7. Marketplace Content

PacketSnitch may offer downloadable or purchasable themes, plugins, and other digital content.

Such purchases may be processed through Paddle or another authorized payment processor.

Themes, plugins, and commercial licenses are subject to the PacketSnitch No Refund Policy.

8. Software Updates

oxasploits may provide software updates, bug fixes, security patches, feature enhancements, or compatibility improvements.

Nothing in this Agreement obligates oxasploits to continue development, maintain compatibility, or provide future updates.

PacketSnitch may include software licensed under one or more open source licenses.

Nothing in this Agreement limits the rights granted under those licenses.
